Re: HLFN COVID 19- Extreme measures

Tansi,

We will now be taking additional “extreme measures” to help or stop the COVID 19 spread into our communities:

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

1. A check point will be put on main paved access TWP 734
2. Following access leading up to our community will be closed,
 - a. North/West, South/West , North/East , and West
3. Children under 12 years of age are now required to not to enter all public spaces/buildings! Parents are asked to stop their children from visiting and practice extreme social/physical distancing.
4. Nationwide curfew hours will be in place from 10pm to 8am (only essential staff delivering goods and providing critical services will be permitted on HLFN roads). Any vehicles or persons not authorised to travel will be sent home.
5. Essential services such as food truck deliveries will still be allowed.

Further to reiterate:

- All persons are to wash their hands (minimum 30 seconds) as soon as they enter their homes or upon entering other person/s home. If at all possible change your clothes when you enter a home. Please refrain from shaking hands and or close contact with other persons. We also ask to limit or stop visiting family members and or friends to help stop the spread of COVID 19
- We need to keep our ELDERS SAFE as they are most vulnerable to COVID 19
- School and day care were closed from March 16th 2020 till further notice in line with the March 15th AHS advisory
- All HLFN essential services will continue to be provided
- Other than essential services employees will be working from home where possible

- All community events are to be postponed and or cancelled till further notice
- Only essential travel is recommended
- All community members are instructed to follow the precautions outlines by Alberta Health Services and refer to COVID 19 Information packages provided and available online (albertahealthservices.ca)
- If you are not from Horse Lake First Nation, you will be turned around at the Security gates. If you have come from a community with confirmed cases, you will be turned away at the security gates.
- All will be screened at the security gates for a fever. If you have a fever you will be asked to quarantine for 14 days, of course if your symptoms get worse you will call 911 for an ambulance to pick you up to take you to the hospital.

These measures are to defect anyone with Covid-19. If everyone on the Nation practices self isolation, we will be out of the woods sooner then later.
